Description:

For your HTML Getting to Know Your Project, you will prepare 1 HTML document. Your page will include information about you, your school activities, hobbies and interests. You will need to include information about your talents or skills that would be useful in team projects. Finally include any additional information that would be interesting or useful in getting to know you.

Goals:

1. To present information about you
2. To showcase your new skills in HTML page design

Content:

You need to break your page into three sections that start below your title.

Section 1 – Introduction paragraph picture

Section 2 – Your school activities. Hobbies and things that you like to do in your spare time.

Section 3 – Information about your family including family members, where you have lived, and where you have gone to school and places where you have traveled.

Section 4 – Information about skills and talents that are valuable when working in team projects.

Technical:

1. Title on Page
2. Bold text for each section head and larger font for each section head
3. Body text with a different color from the headline text and a smaller font
4. Text spaced with line spacing
5. 4 Pictures with
 - a. Links to 2 pictures on your flashdrive
 - b. Links to 2 pictures on the Internet from 2 different websites
 - c. All 4 pictures linked to display on the page
6. Horizontal rules on your page to break up your sections
7. Credit for the page author at the bottom of the page and the date that the page was created. Your e-mail address at the bottom of the document
8. Coherent style (yes, that's a must)
